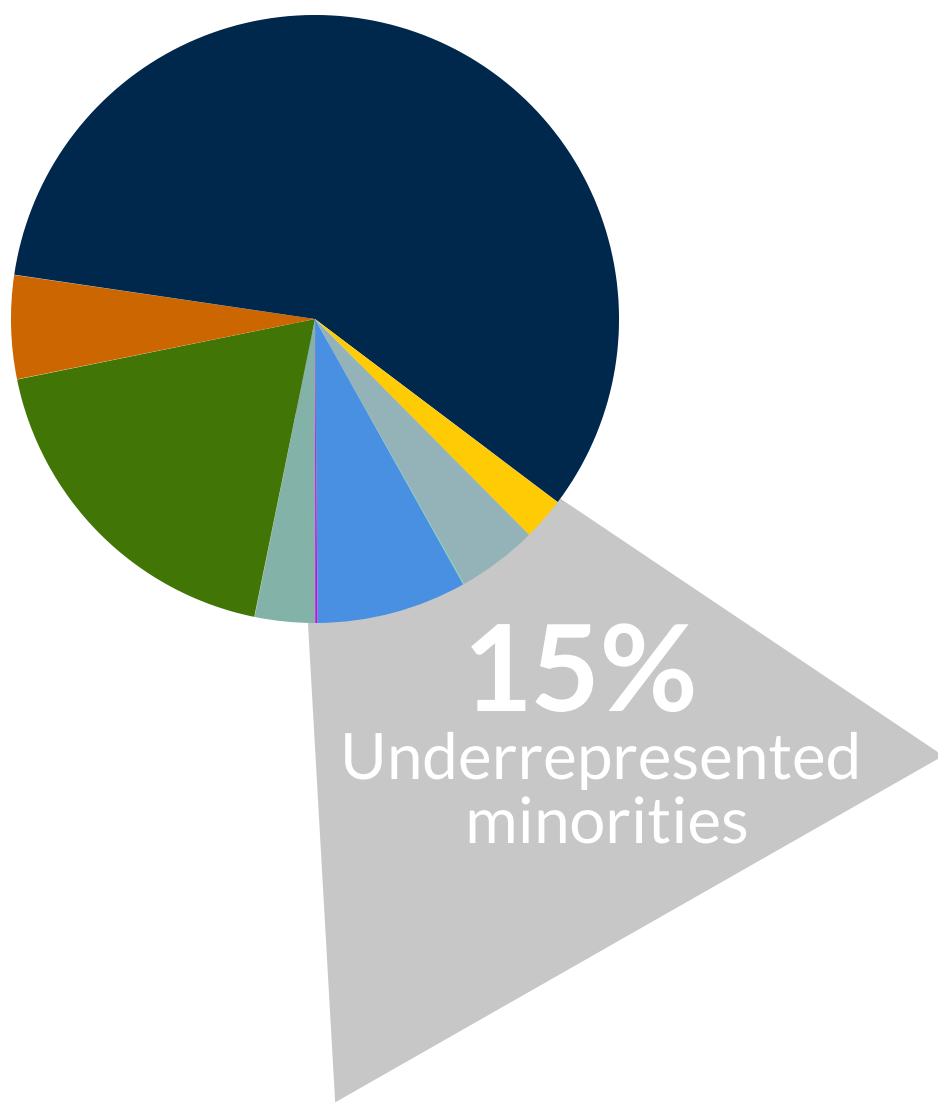

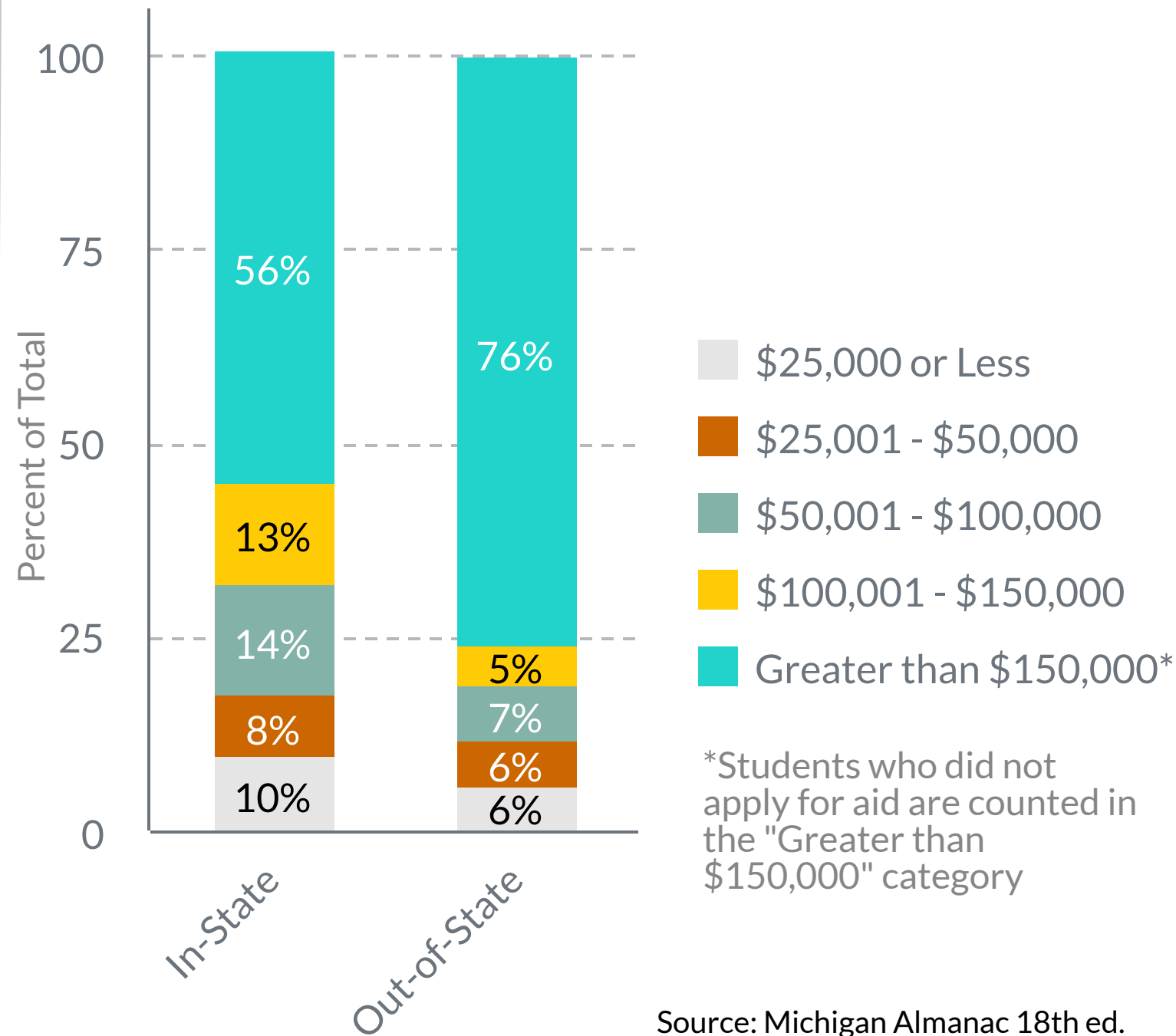

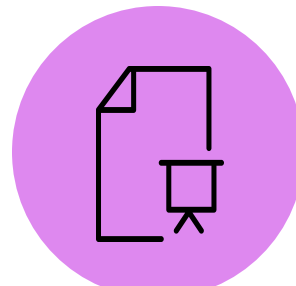

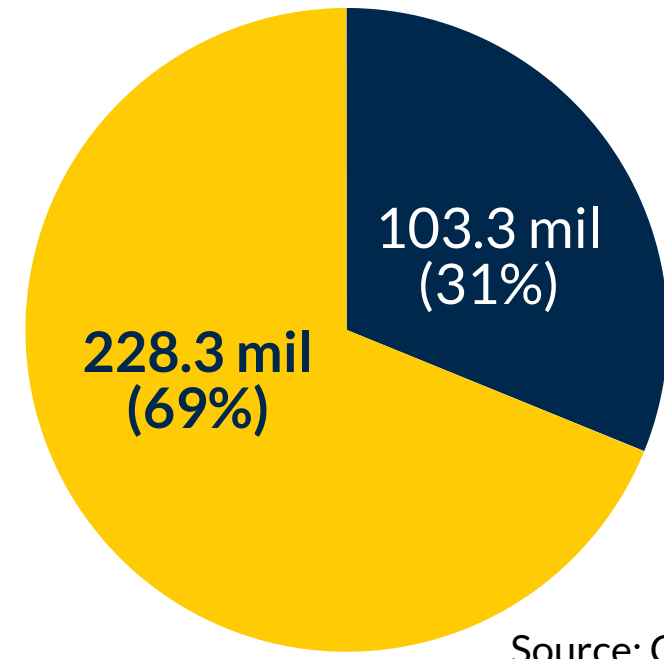

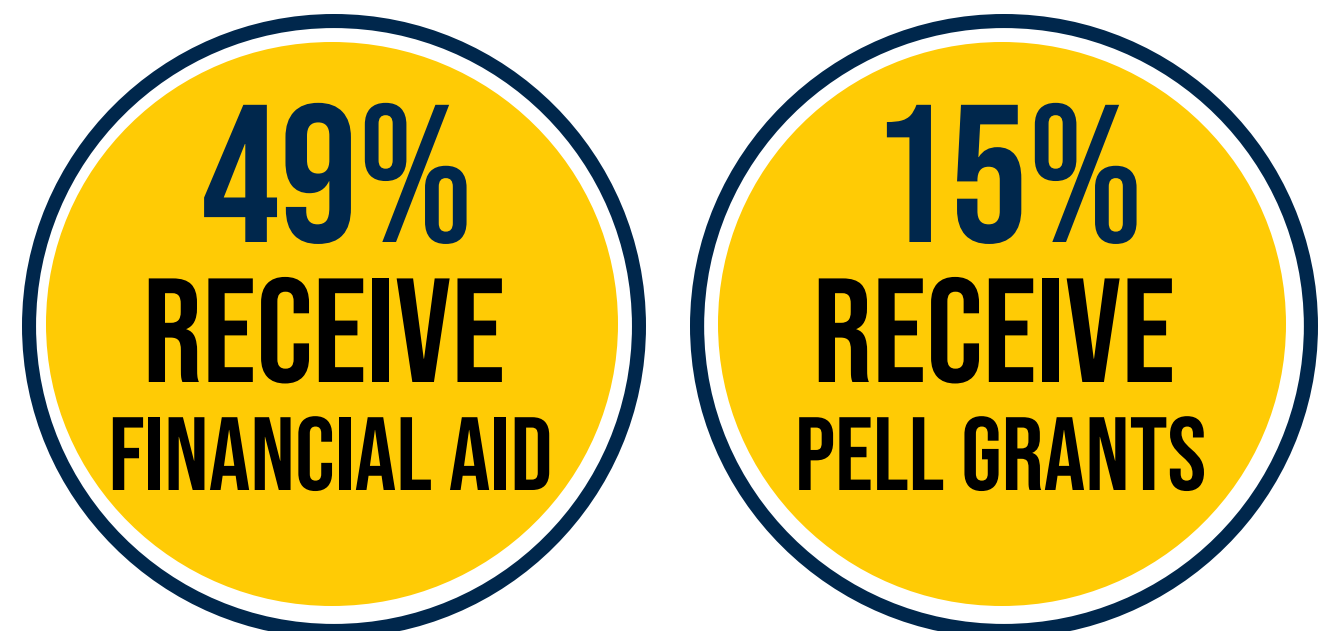

### OUT-OF-STATE UNDERGRADUATES

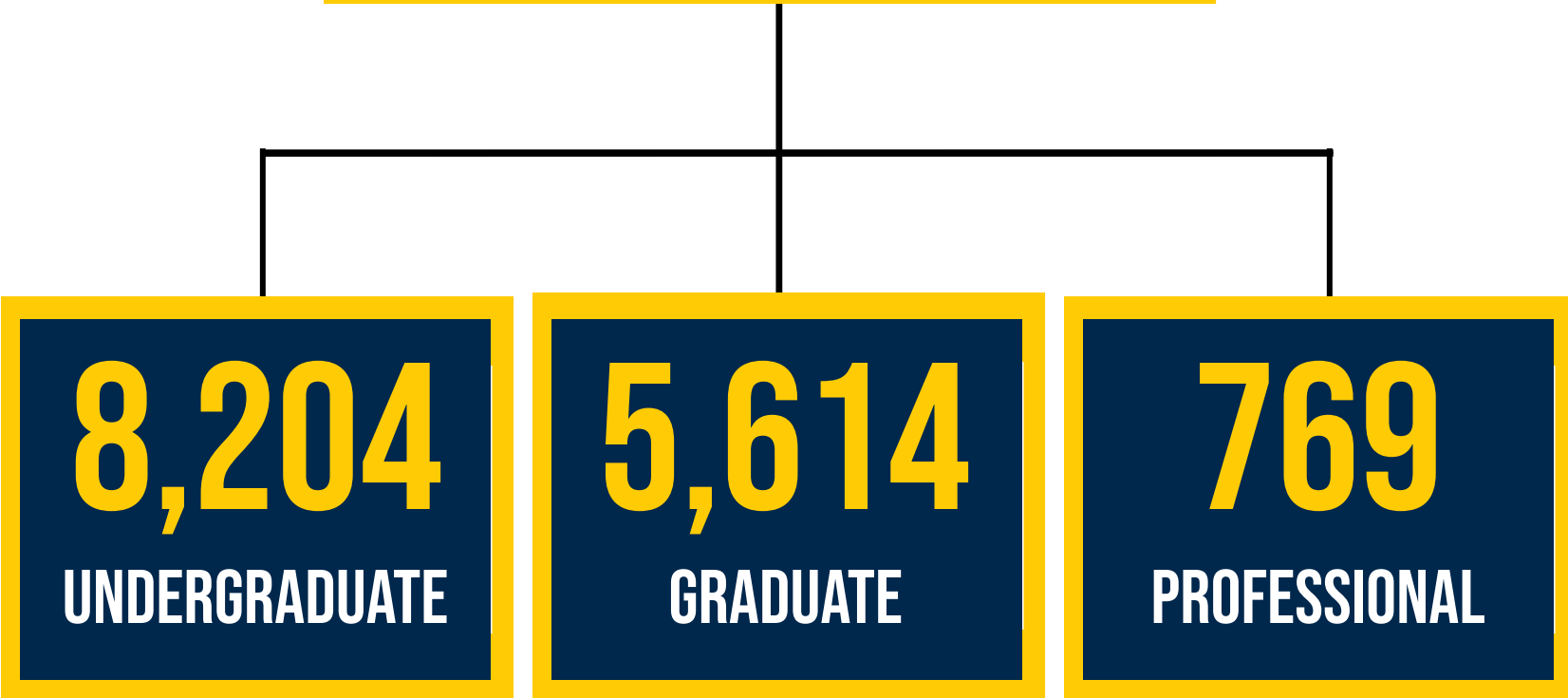

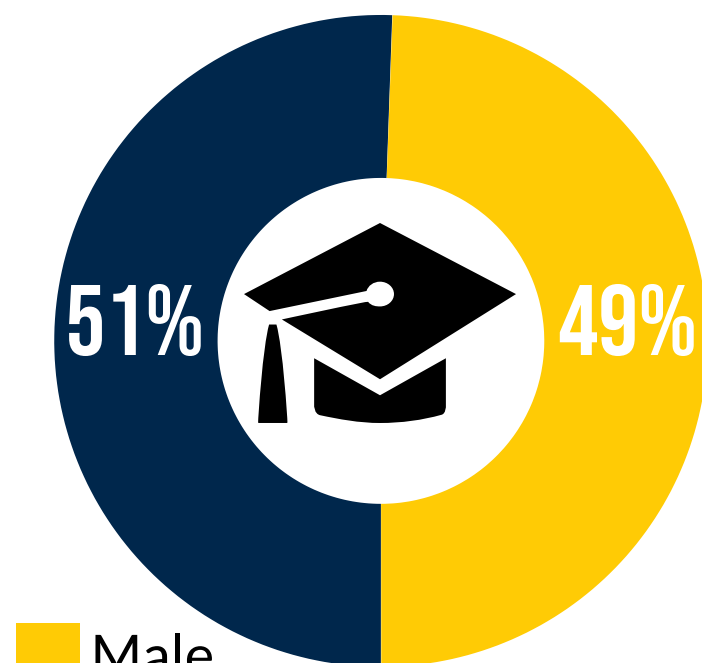

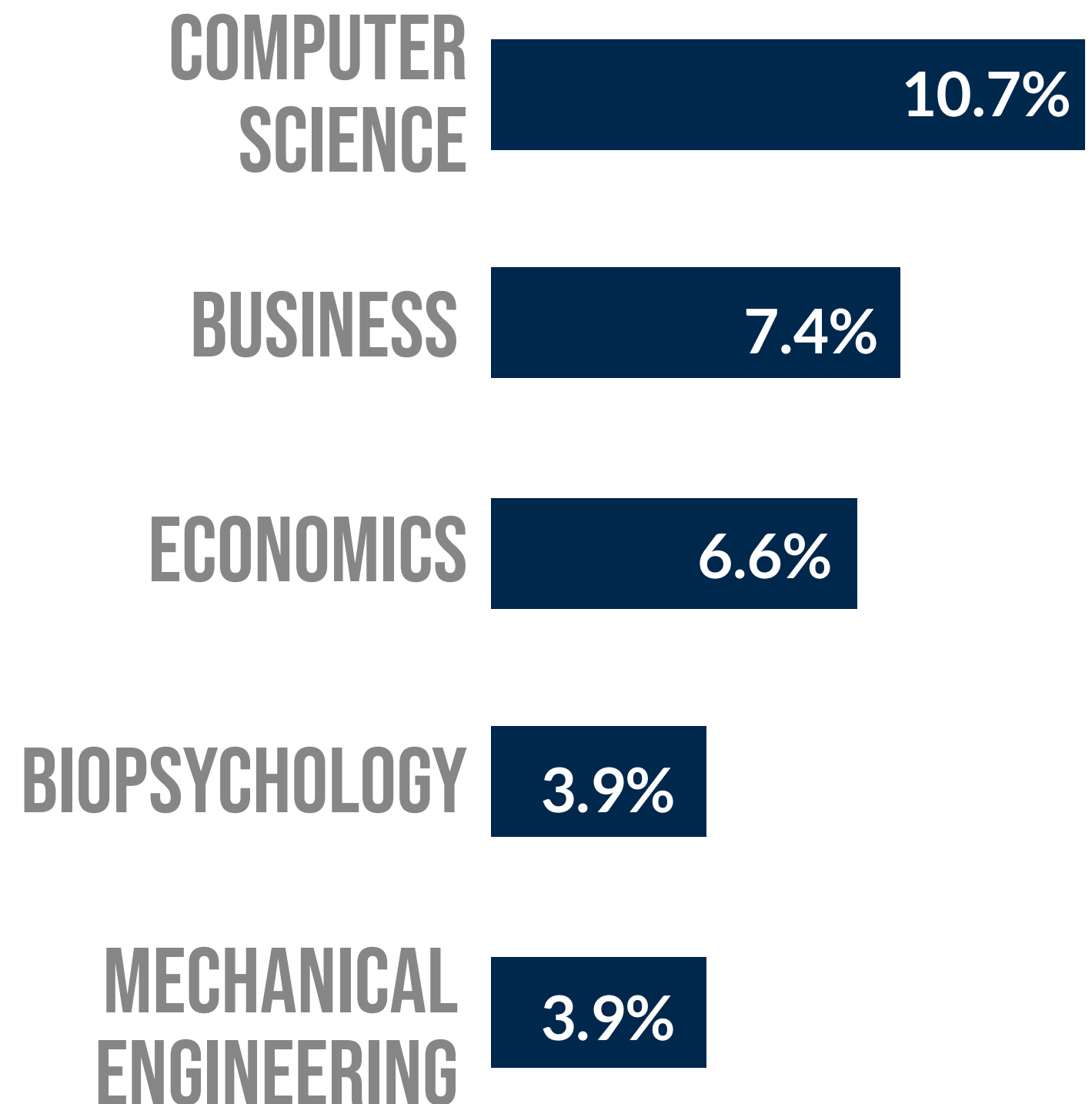

## MOST POPULAR DEGREES AMONG UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE RECIPIENTS



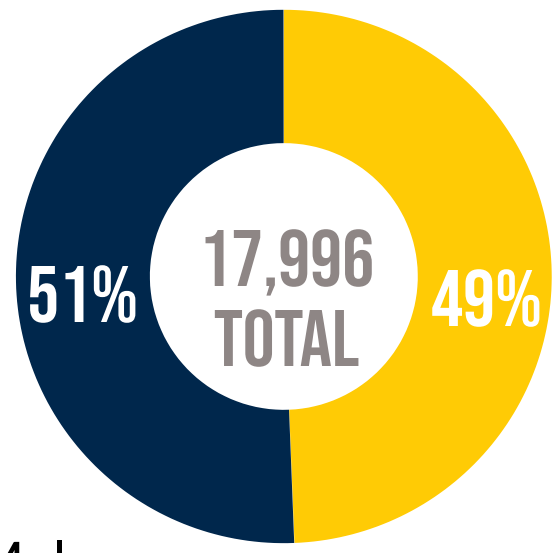
