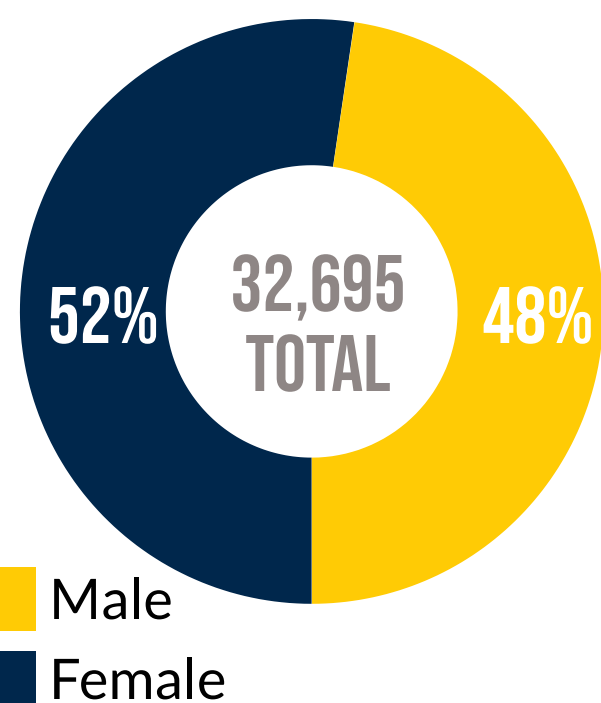

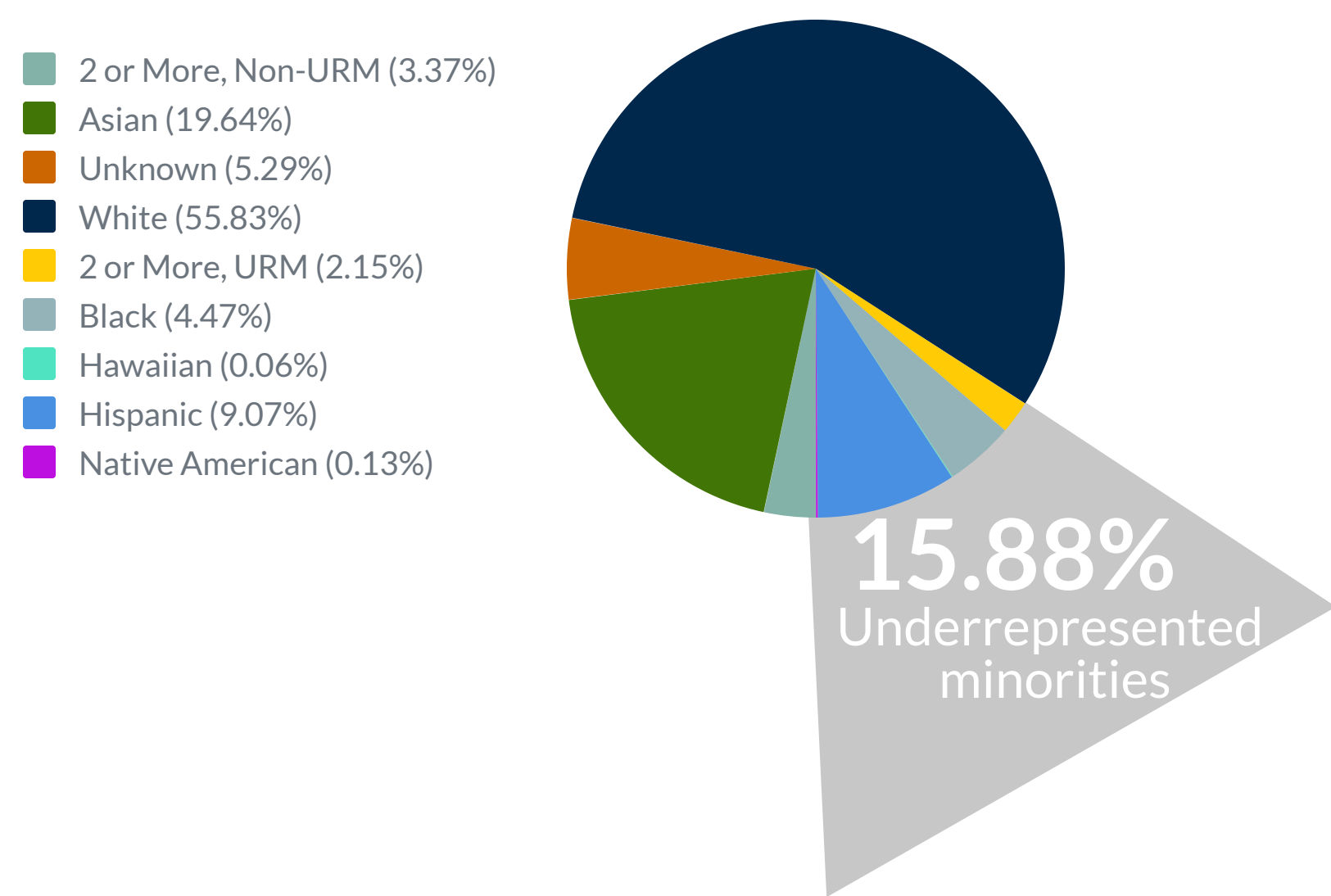

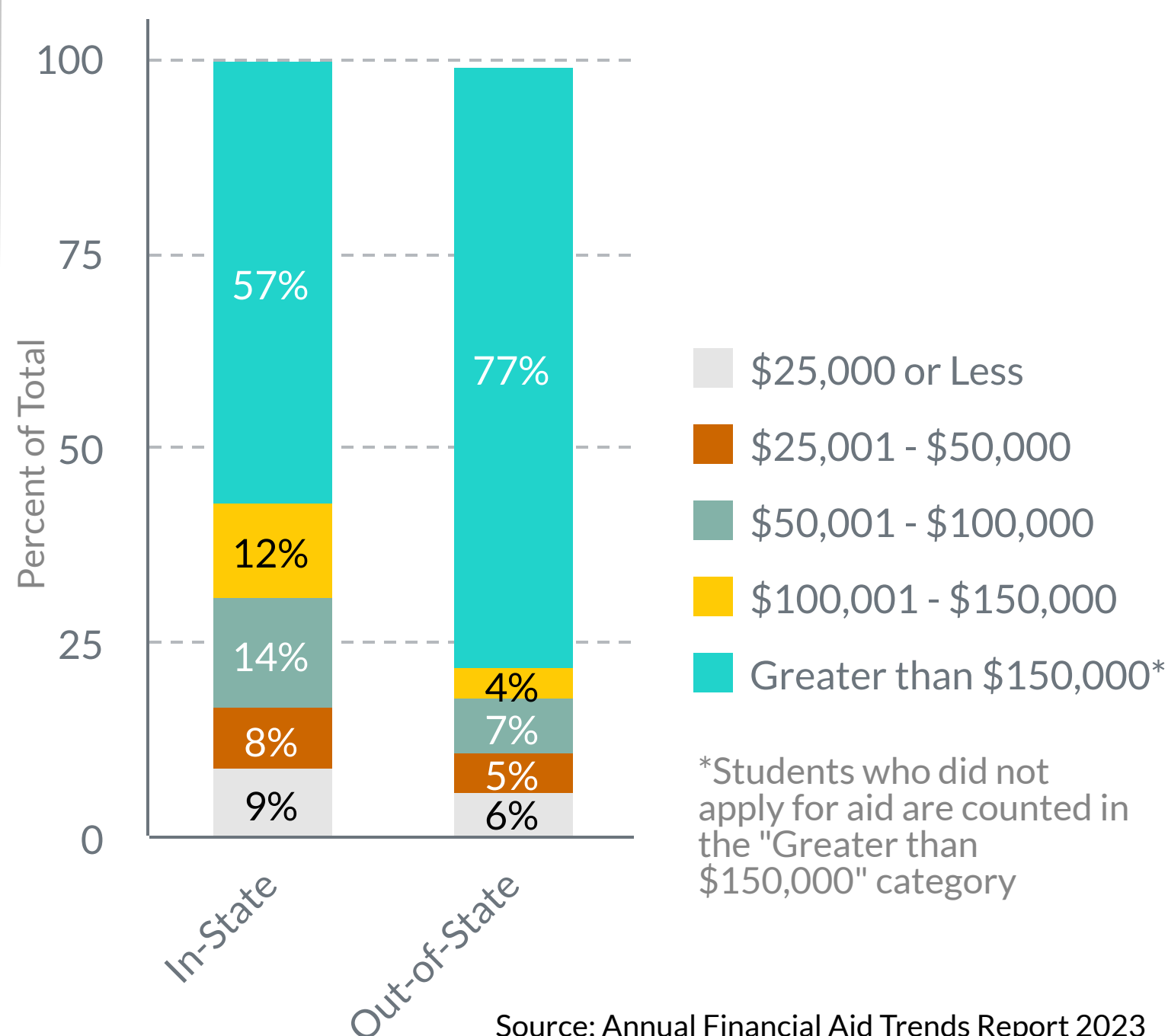

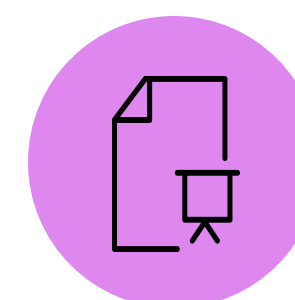

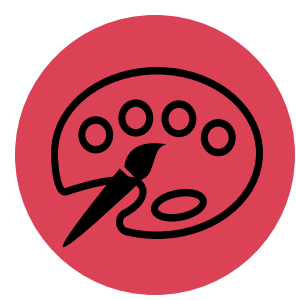

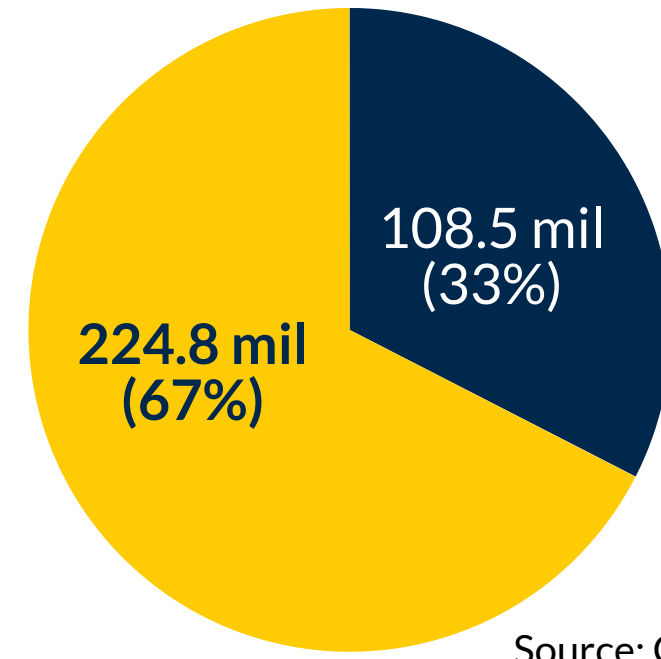

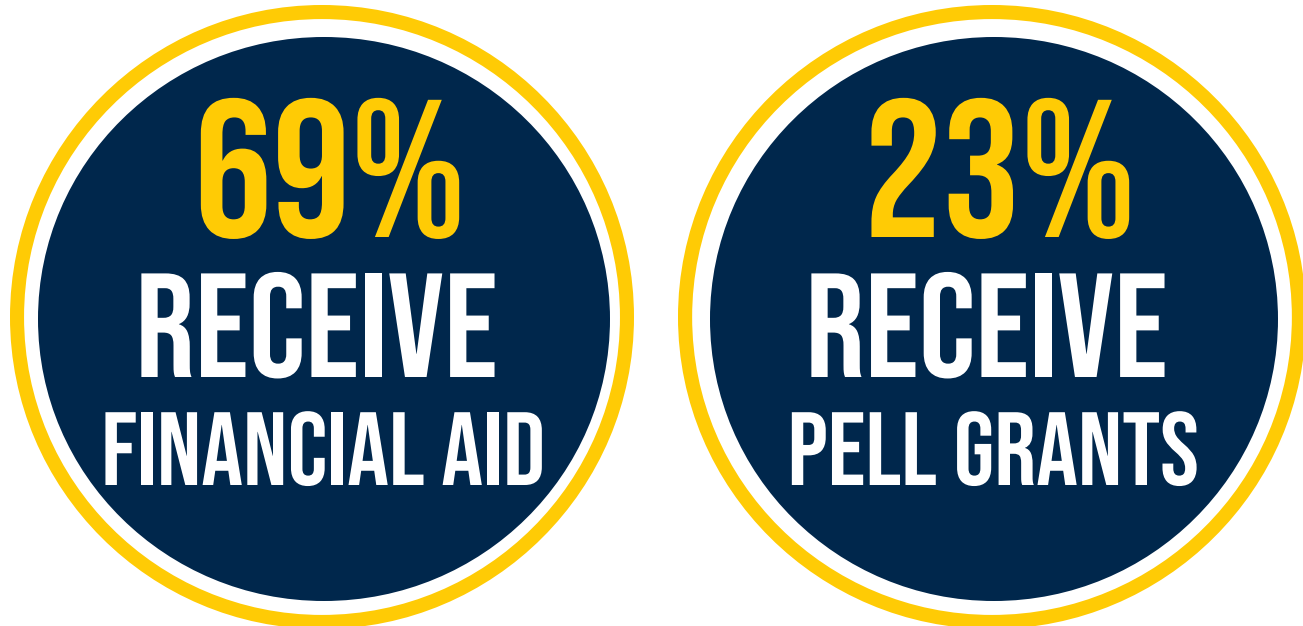

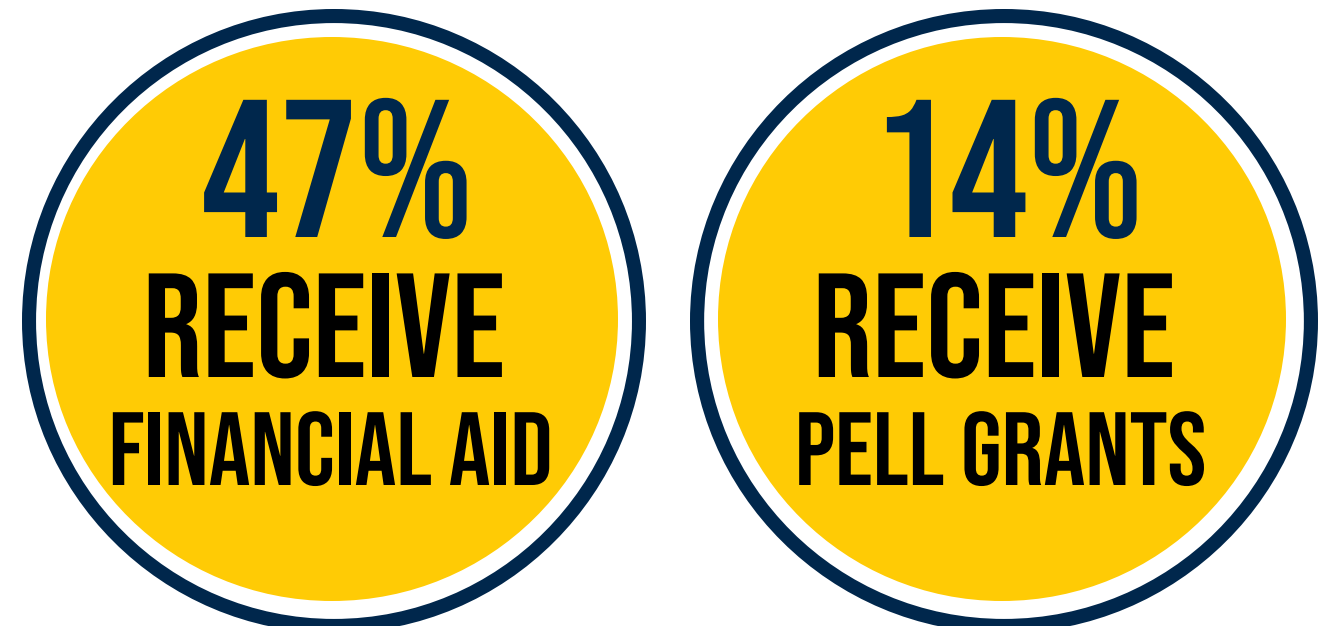

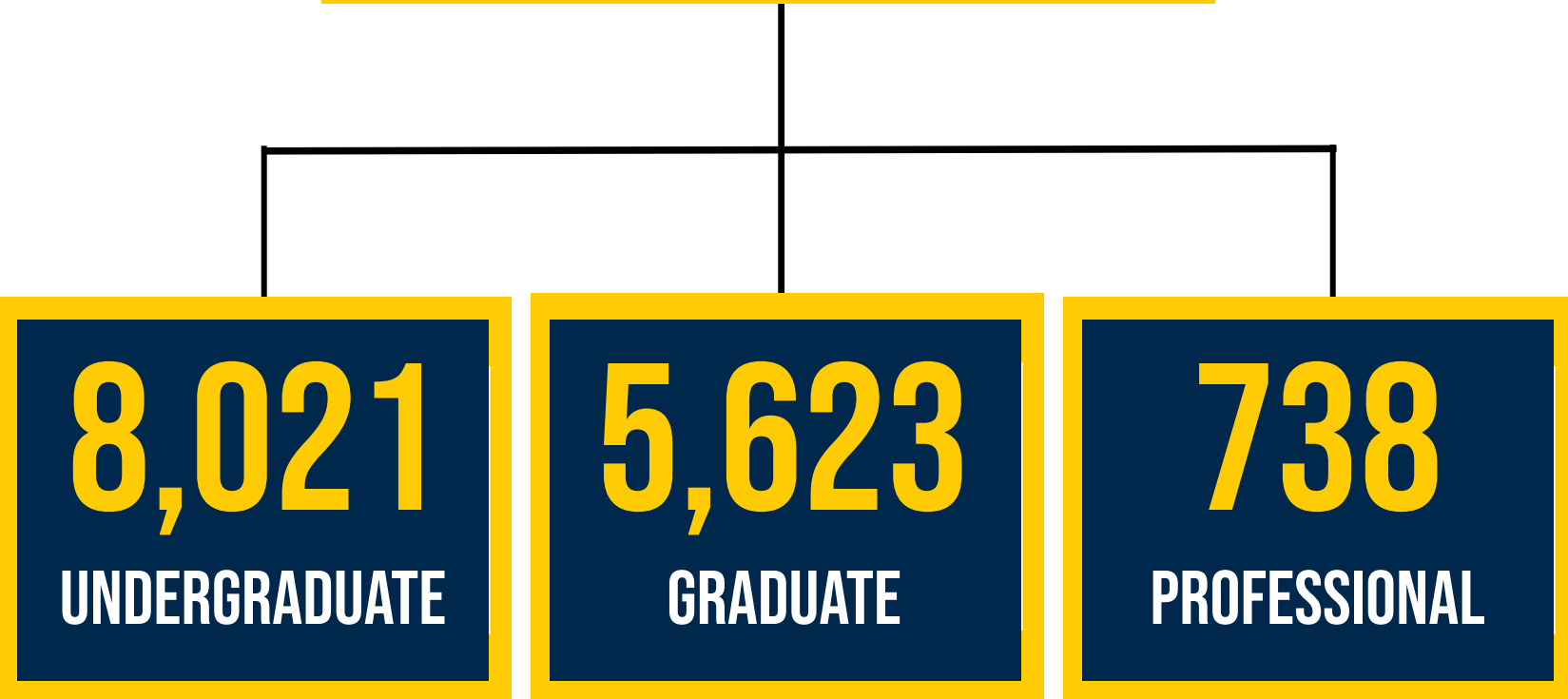
OUT-OF-STATE UNDERGRADUATES

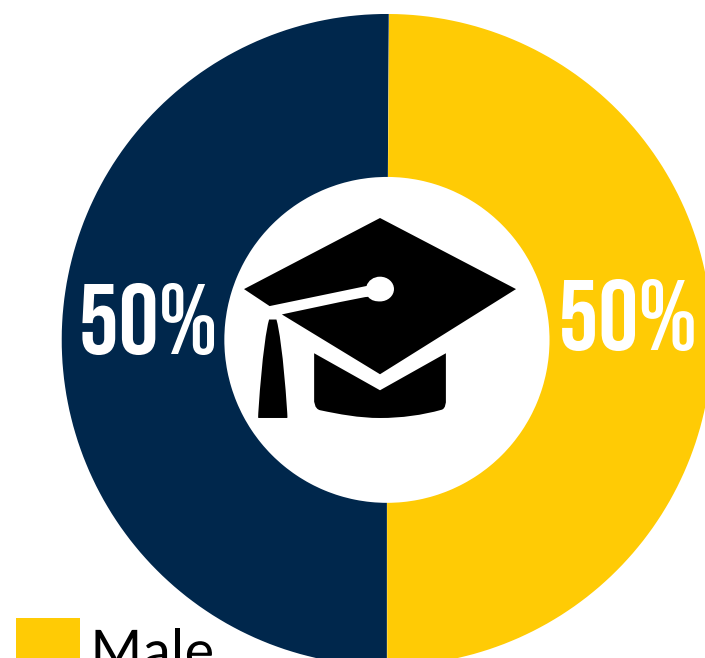
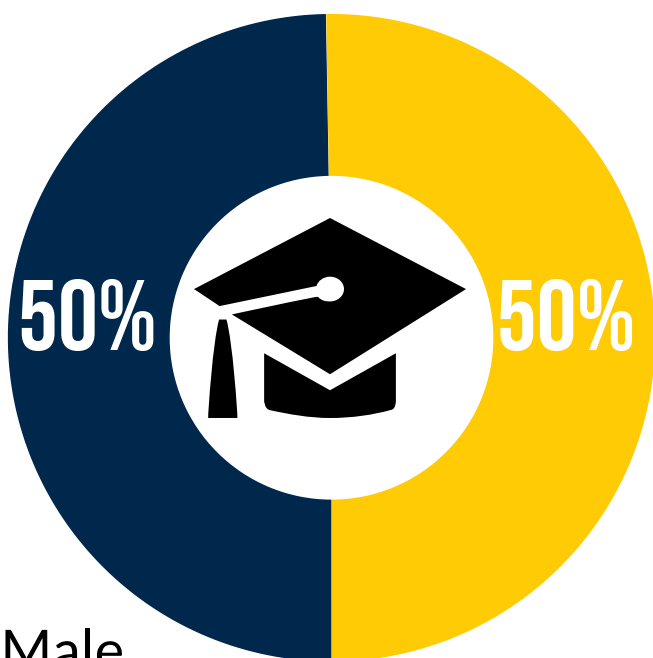

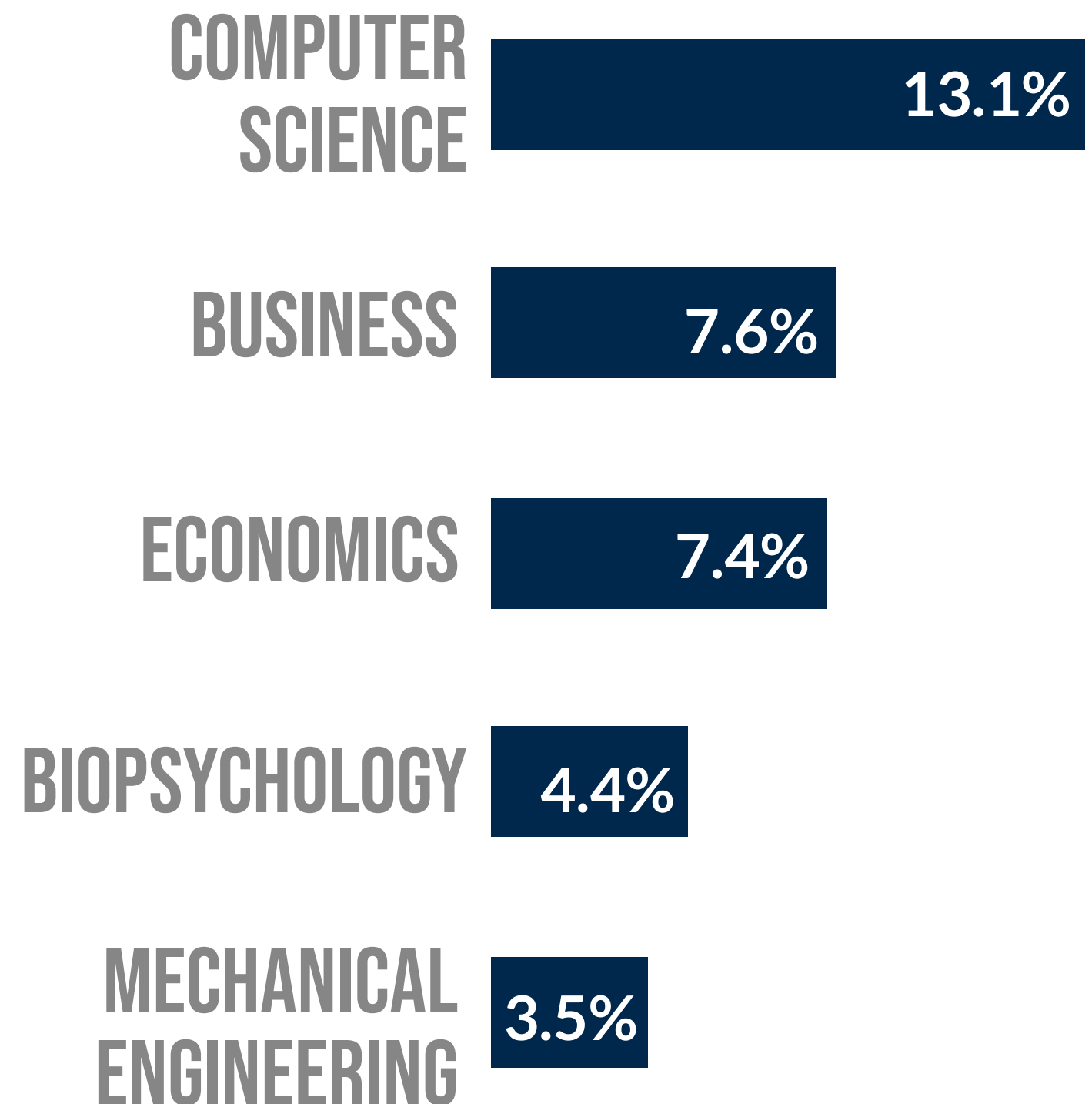

MOST POPULAR DEGREES AMONG UNDERGRADUATE DEGREE RECIPIENTS



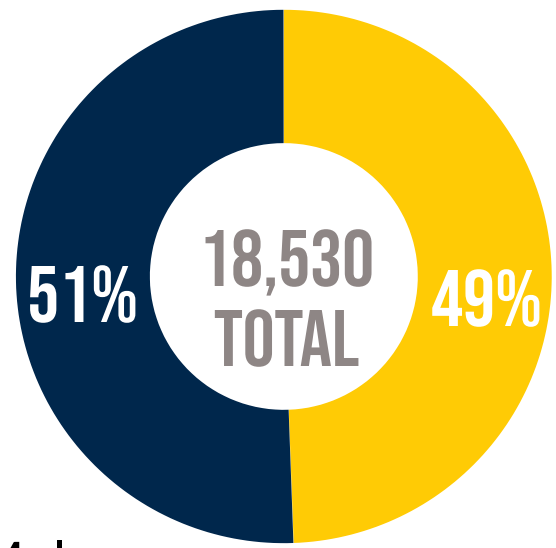

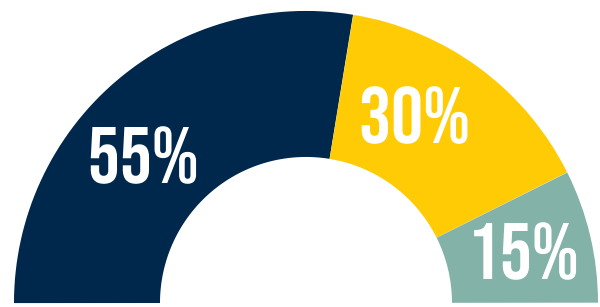

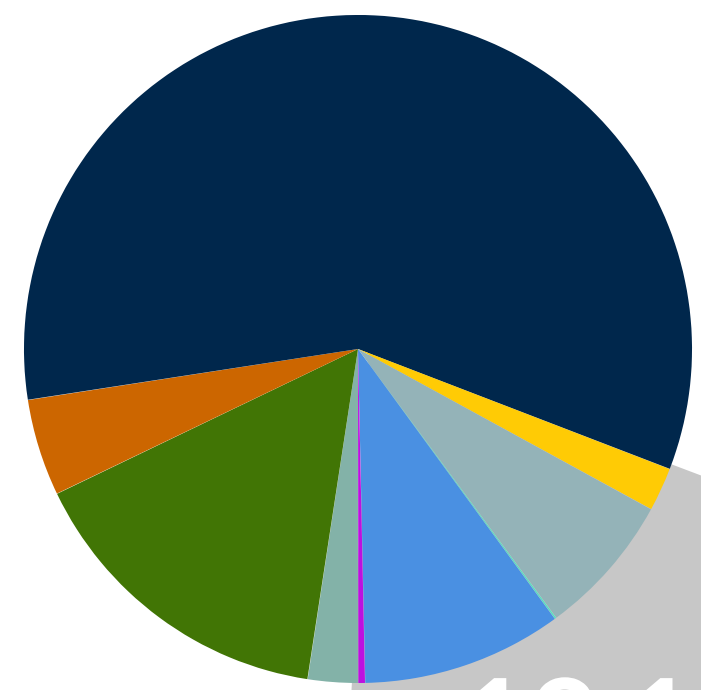

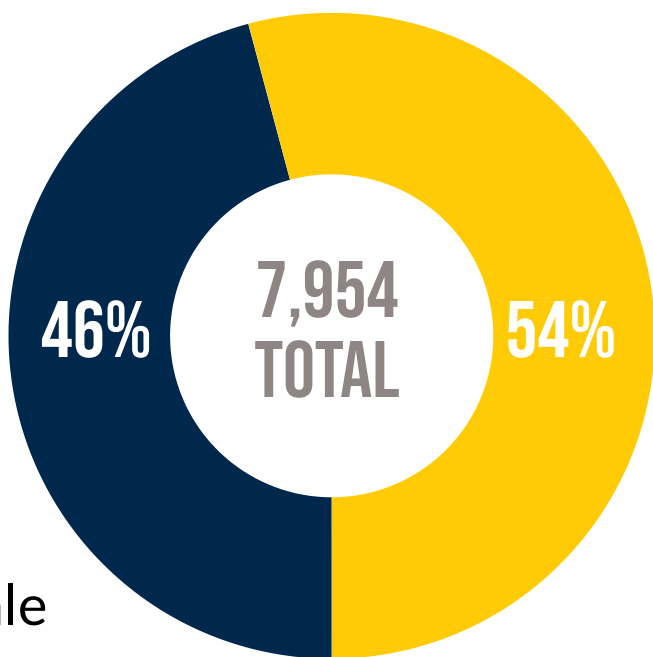

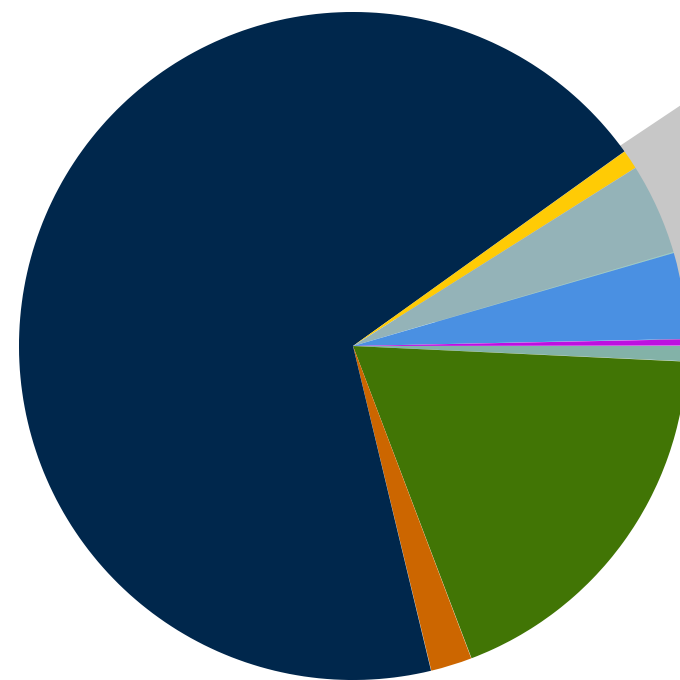

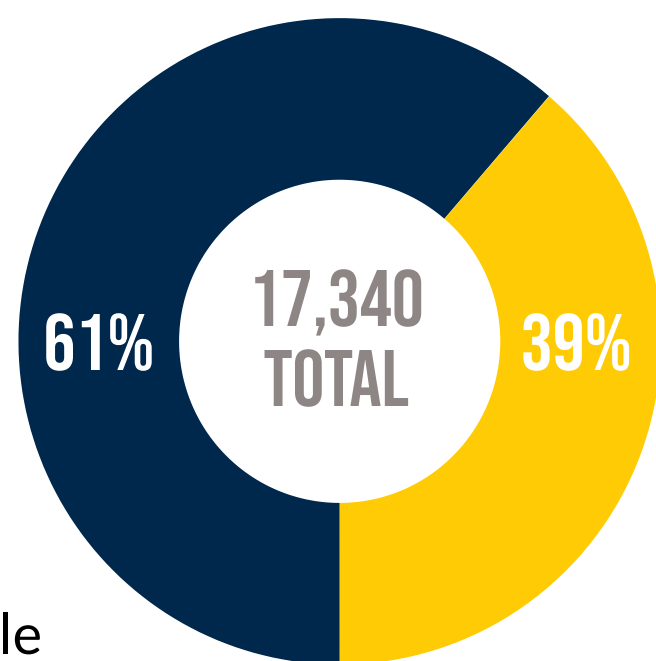

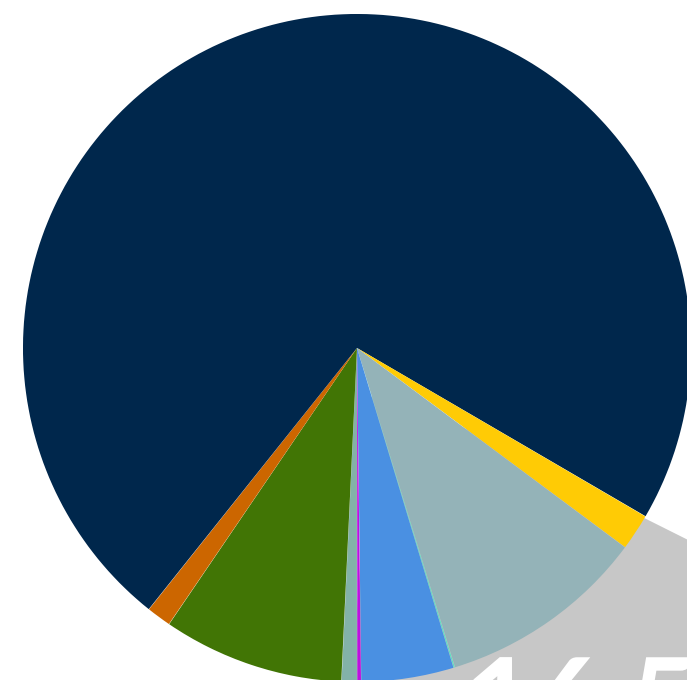
