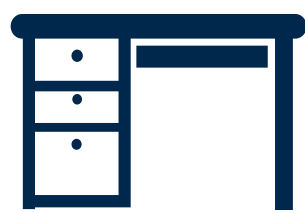

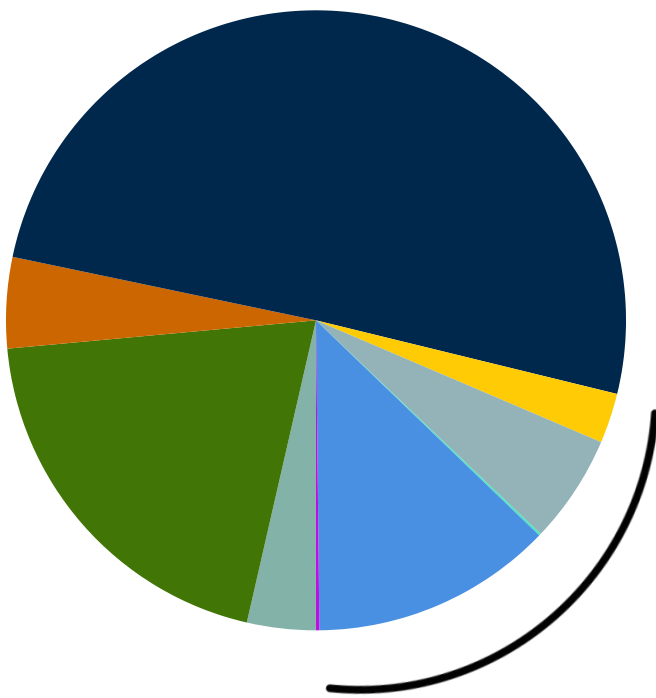

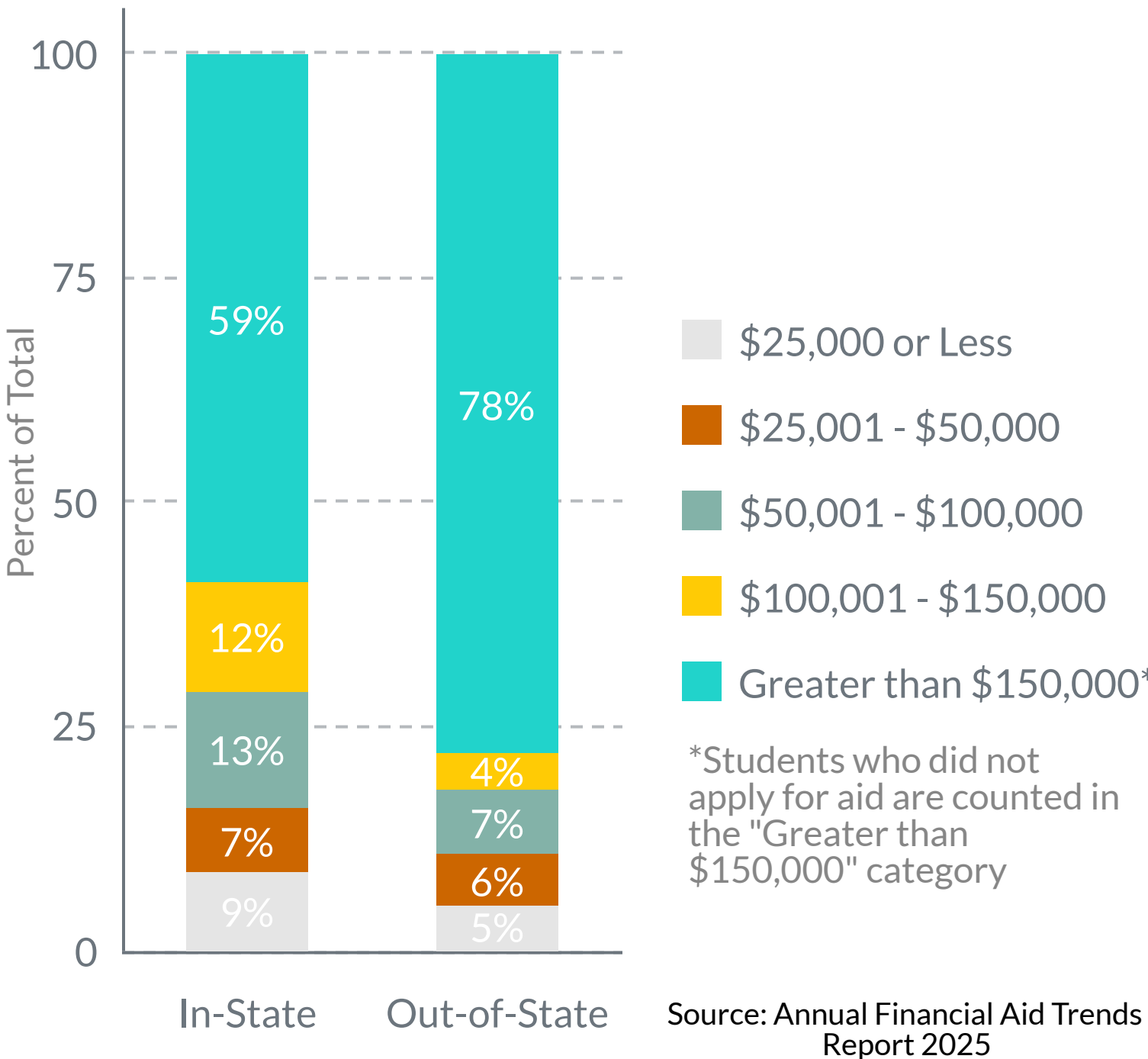

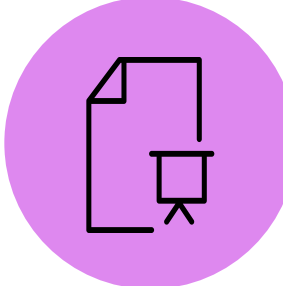

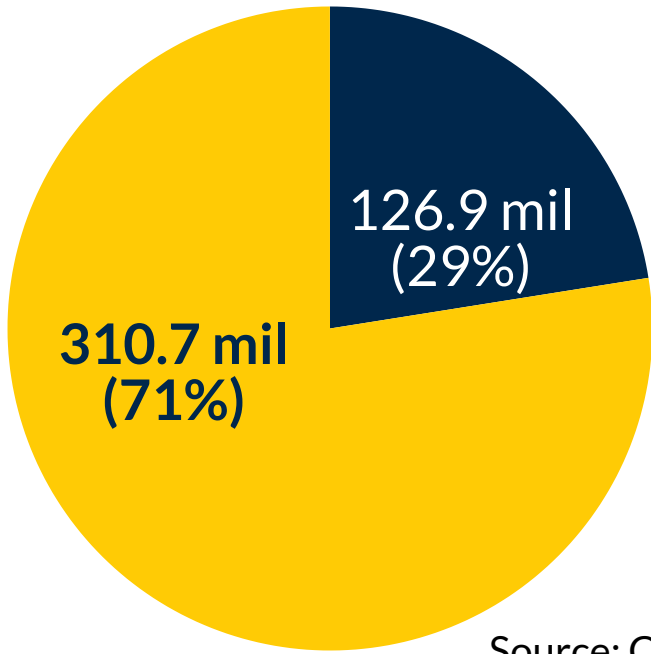

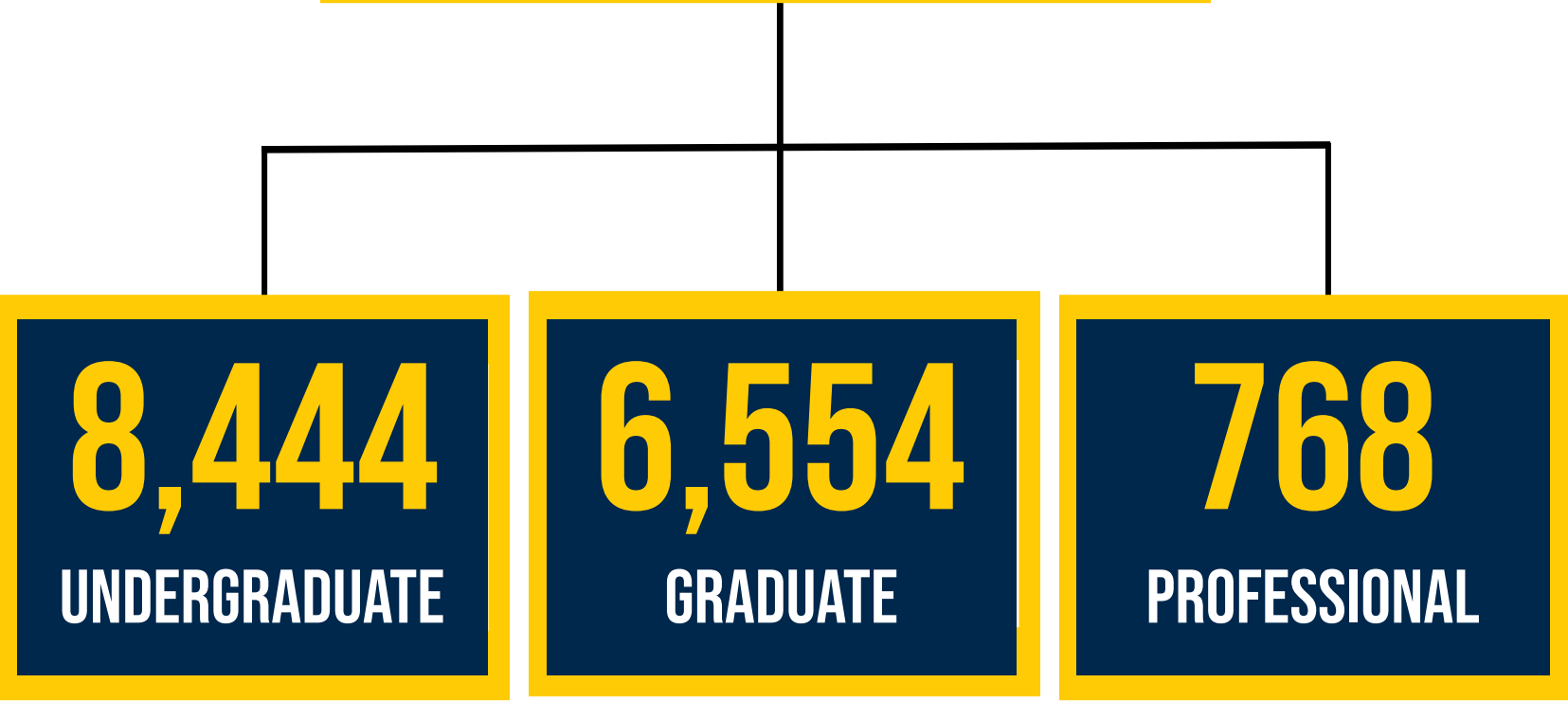
OUT-OF-STATE UNDERGRADUATES

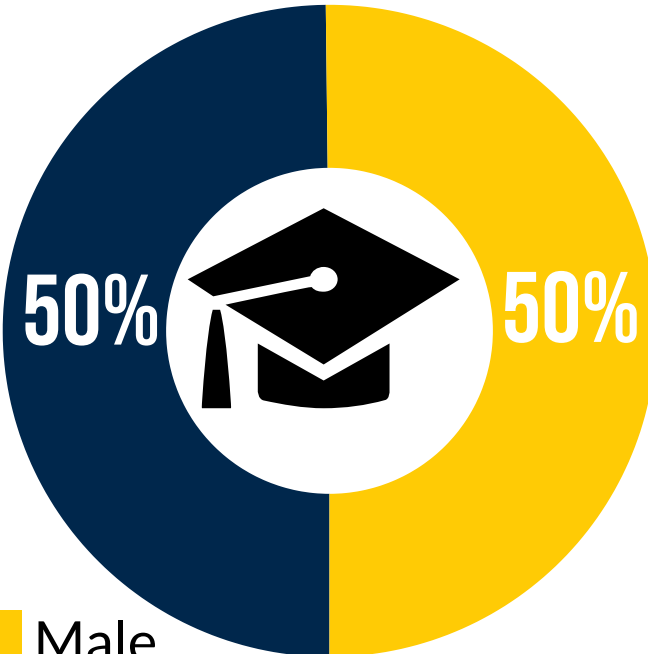
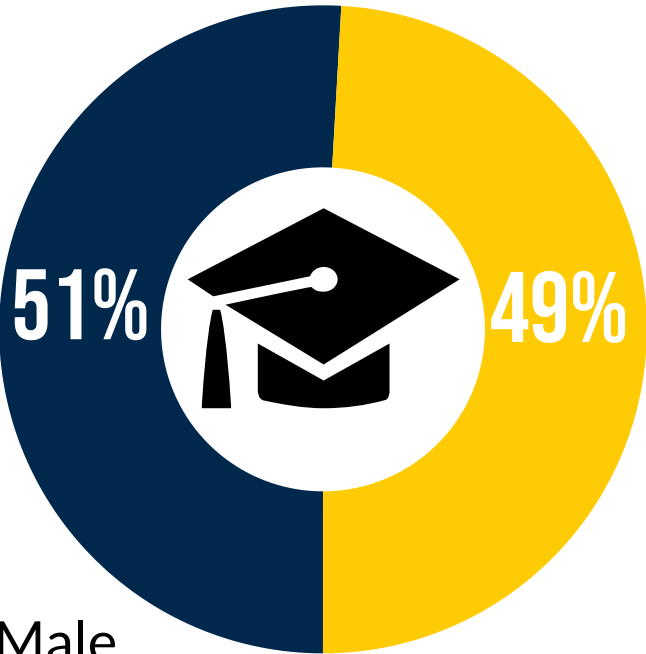

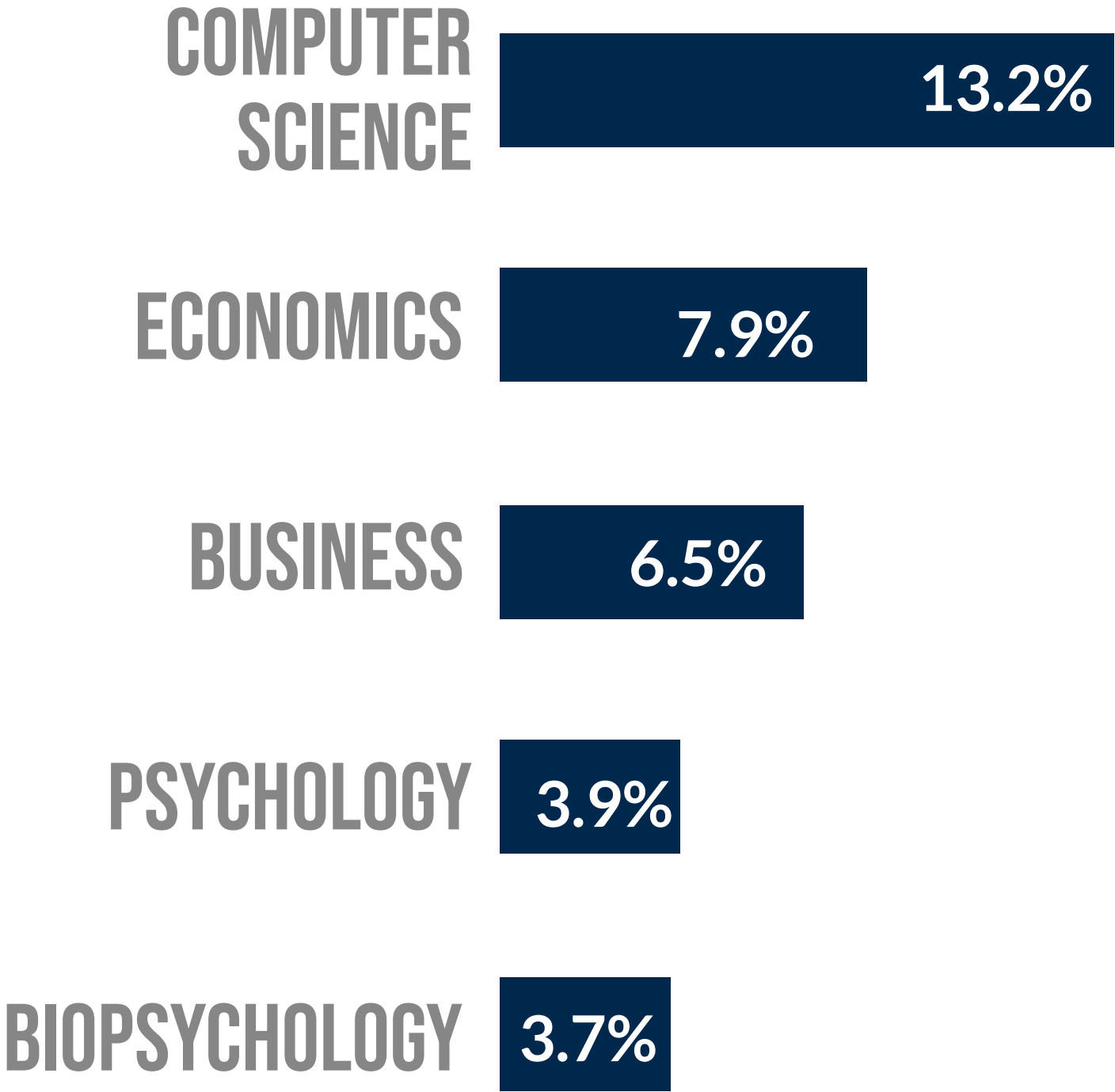
