In reference to Section 275g of Public Act 86 of 2021, the University of Michigan is providing a description of the federal funds received to address the needs created by the COVID-19 global pandemic. Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act made emergency relief funds available under the following federal legislation in FY 2020 through FY 2022.

Coronavirus Relief Fund (CRF): \$36,708,738
Institutional: \$36,084,600
Child Care Relief Fund Grant: \$412,029
Early warning and intervention in college dormitories and virus surveillance: \$212,109

Higher Education Emergency Relief Fund (HEERF): \$25,244,052
Institutional: \$12,622,026
Financial Aid: \$12,622,026

Coronavirus Response and Relief Supplemental Appropriations Act, 2021 (HEERF II):

Provider Relief Funds: \$1,106,976 was awarded to the School of Dentistry for personal protection equipment used in clinics.

Coronavirus Emergency Supplemental Funding: \$35,904 was awarded to the Division of Safety and Security for personal protection equipment.
